
Diverse boards are essential to strengthen nonprofits and communities:

A Strategic Solution

The **Nonprofit Leadership Center's Advancing Racial Equity on Nonprofit Boards Fellowship** is a 15-week program that provides comprehensive board governance training and ongoing mentorship to professionals of color while equipping participating nonprofits to authentically welcome fellows to their boards.



Impact to Date

40%

Fellows report a **40% increase in their knowledge and skills** after completing the program.

86%

86% of fellows have been invited to serve on a nonprofit board or are in active conversations with at least one organization about board service.
